

Instructions for authors of abstracts for all contributions to VUVX2016

The title should be written in bold with times new roman 16 and centred like in this template

Authors' names should be given in times new roman 12 and centred like in the following:

H.B. Smith¹, R. Better^{2,3}, A. Great³, etc.

Affiliations should be formatted with times new roman 10 and centred like below

¹*Department/Research Institute, University, Country...*

²*Department/Research Institute, University, Country, email@corresponding.author*

³*Department/Research Institute, University, Country,*

Summary

There must be one blank line between the title, the authors' names and their affiliations and one blank line between the affiliation and the beginning of the body text. Authors and affiliations preferably should not exceed one line each. The name of the presenting author is underlined. The affiliation of the corresponding author should be followed by the corresponding author email address (see example above).

All abstracts must be written in English (UK or US consistently) and occupy maximum 2 pages A4 written in times new roman 12, single-spaced, aligned in mode "justify". Please make sure to set the following margins: top, bottom, right: 2.5 cm; left: 3.0 cm.

Headings

The abstract should start with a paragraph giving a brief summary (max 100 words), which is also required to be directly pasted into the submission form. The heading "**Summary**" in bold with times new roman 12 should be inserted directly above this summary paragraph. The remaining main part of the abstract can be further divided in paragraphs that may have headings if it is required for structuring purposes.

The acknowledgments (if desired) should appear in the text under the heading "**Acknowledgments**" in bold, times new roman 10. The "**Acknowledgments**" heading should follow after a blank line below the body text. The text of the acknowledgments should be formatted in times new roman 10.

Reference citations [1] are shown in the text by a number in brackets and follow after a blank line below the "**Acknowledgments**" under the heading "**References**" in bold, times new roman 10. The correct format for references (in times new roman 10) is the following:

1. Book: Author(s). Book title (in italics). Place of publication: Publisher. Page (Year of publication)

Example:

M. Johnston and W. R. Cook *Cosmic Space*. New York: John Wiley and Sons Inc. 278 (1969)

2. Journal article: Author(s), *Journal Title* Volume number in bold, page number (Year of publication)

Example:

L. J. Sure and G. Notreally, *Phys. Rev. B* **43**, 5897 (2016)

3. Conference Proceedings: Author(s). In: *Proceedings of...*, place and year of the conference. Place of publication: Publisher. Page (year of publication)

Example:

E. J. Freedom. In: *Proceedings of the 6th Medical Congress*, Cracow, 1990. Warsaw: Voice of Medicine. 1129 (1991)

Formulas (if used) should be designed in a uniform style keeping used fonts and symbols with the same sizes throughout the whole text. For numbered formulas the formula itself should be located on the left edge of the text and the number on the right edge. Recommended font sizes are the following: 12pt – full symbols and equations, 7pt – subscripts/superscripts, 5pt – sub-subscripts/superscripts.

If figures or images are included in the abstract, please insert them as .jpg or .tiff files.

To ensure a smooth abstract booklet preparation, please **do not** insert text or references in “footnote” mode or other encoding.

Please submit abstracts in **.pdf format only!** Maximum size 2MB.

Acknowledgments

The acknowledgments written in times new roman 10 should appear in the text under the heading “**Acknowledgments**”. The “**Acknowledgments**” heading should follow after one blank line below the text body.
